## About the Tournament

For the past seven years, students from the HUHS feeder elementary and middle school chess clubs have culminated their chess club seasons with a spring tournament at the high school. Hopefully a new tradition can be added with this fall tournament as well. Like the spring tournament, this tournament is non-USCF rated, using a Swiss-pairing system utilizing club ratings for those clubs that have ratings and giving other players an average rating based on their grade in school. The ratings are used to determine initial opponents for the Swiss-pairing system. The games will be un-timed, though a clock may be placed on a match that is running long. There will be between 4 and 6 rounds of play, with each player playing in all or all but one of the rounds. The Great Lakes Central Model Railroad Club is planning to sell food and drinks, but players may bring along snacks as well. The tournament should be finished by 2:30 p.m. Awards are given out at 3pm.
